Residing in New York City but originally from Massachusetts, Paige Manley received most of her dance training traveling to conventions and workshops throughout the United States. She has studied with world renowned choreographers including Jason Winters, Mia Michaels, Tyce Diorio, Sheryl Murakami, Sonya Tayeh, and Toni Gendreau. She was one of the few dancers selected by the famous Los Angeles choreographer, Brian Friedman, to train with him and to perform his work at a gala event in New York City. In 2008, Paige spent six months interning at the prestigious Broadway Dance Center in Manhattan where she was recognized by its directors as a powerful young choreographer with a promising future.

Paige has been featured in TV shows such as *Gossip Girl* and MTV's *Dancelife* and will be appearing in the upcoming movies, *Step Up 3D* and *Wall Street 2* starring Shia Labeouf. She recently founded her own *Scarlet Fever Dance Company* in New York City and serves as its creative director and choreographer.

Paige has been able to choreograph and perform with many of the next generation of professional dancers. She has taught and choreographed at many schools in New York and Massachusetts, in Sweden and along side Tony Award winning Broadway stars at the *Beginnings* Workshops in New York, considered to be the most complete arts experience for aspiring young performers.

Paige's movement is athletic, genuine and intense. Her goal as a choreographer is to open the hearts and minds of dancers and invite them to experience "real life" situations through the art of dance. Her classes are invigorating and powerful. Her contemporary movement incorporates both modern and jazz while also inviting dancers to explore and express their own emotions through improvisation techniques.

Paige lives by her favorite word, "Believe." She encourages all of her students to use their imaginations because she believes that "Life isn't about *finding* yourself, but rather *creating* yourself".
